


## FLOWER-MAKING TUTORIAL - CUT CARDBOARD

This tutorial is for a simplified version of a cardboard flower, which uses cut flower shapes in 3 sizes. Use these three basic shapes along with pipe cleaners, buttons, and beads of your choice to assemble something of your own imagination. IMPORTANT - please use the provided tag to attach a thank-you message to EACH & EVERY flower you make!

**SUPPLIES:** Printed cartons pre-cut in 6" x 4 1/2" and 3 1/2" diameter flower shapes; two pipe cleaners, buttons (two holes), assorted beads.

1.) Insert pipe cleaners through buttons and holes in flowers as shown. 2.) TIGHTLY twist pipe cleaners above and below flower assembly. Make sure the flower assembly is snug and tightly secured with twisted pipe cleaners. 3.) Insert pipe both cleaners through large bead and pull bead down to cover twist on top 4.) Curl, or bend pipe cleaners and embellish with beads. When complete, bend tips of pipe cleaners over to secure beads in place. Bend and shape the cardboard petals to give dimension to the flower. 5.) Example of a completed flower. And then the most important part - attach the tag with your message of thanks - NOW YOU ARE FINISHED!
